
There is an increasing need for infanttoddler services, mental health services, and early childhood/health connections in San Francisco, and FACES SF is interested in providing more of these services.

# School-Age Programming




In addition to early childhood services, at our Bayview campus we provide before- and afterschool programming that focuses on academic tutoring, socialemotional support, and hands-on enrichment. We serve about 80 students each year with funding from DCYF and state childcare grants.
