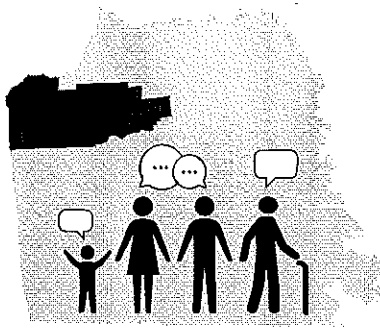

- How can we impact/incentivize landlords to expand houses.

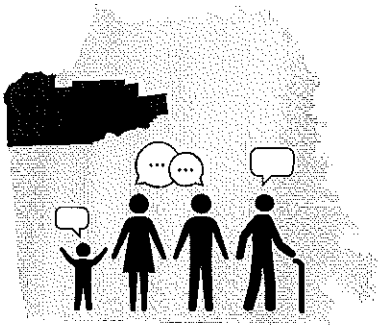
